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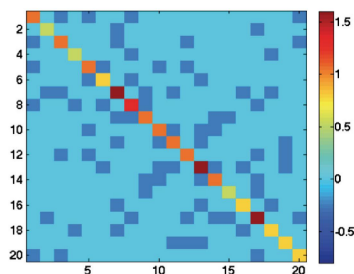
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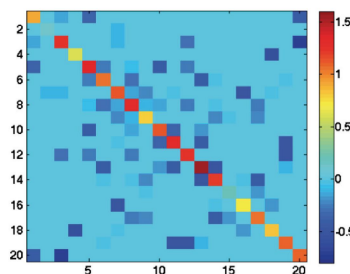
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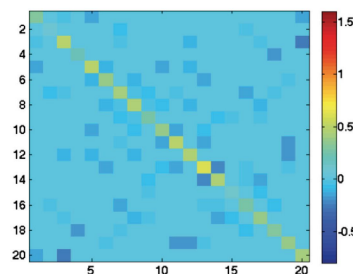
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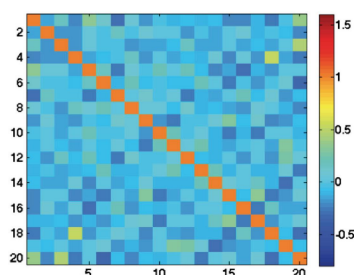

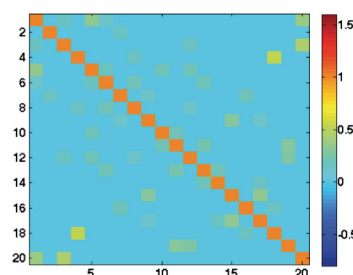

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About the Cover: The graphic on the cover depicts a segment of the Fig. 2 provided in “Learning Laplacian Matrix in Smooth Graph Signal Representations” by Dong *et al.* on page 6160, which in its entirety shows the learned graph Laplacian matrices as well as sample correlation matrices (original and thresholded). The columns from the left to the right reflect the groundtruth Laplacians, the Laplacians learned by GL-SigRep, the Laplacians learned by GL-LogDet, the sample correlation matrices, and the thresholded sample correlation matrices. The row depicted on the cover reflects the ER graph. The original figure additionally shows the Gaussian RBF graph and the BA graph.
