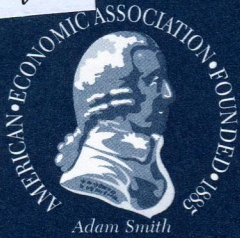

Corresponding figures for June 2013, the issue published nearest to filing date: total number of copies printed, 7,050; total paid circulation, 6,449; total free distribution, 236; total distribution, 6,685.
